

**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner was established by Herman D. Gradon, US Deputy Surveyor, during the original survey Contract No. 416 dated August, 1881. Set a basalt stone 12x12x5 ins 8 in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W. face; from which  
A pine 36 ins diam bears N15°E, (13.9')21 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT  
A pine 38 ins diam bears S35°W, (15.2')23 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT

**Description of corner evidence found:**

14x7x7 stone with 1/4 on W face loosely set on the ground.  
48" Ponderosa pine (36" Stump with log laying alongside) (Scribing Visible) (1881 BT) bears N19° 45'E, 14.7 feet.  
36" Ponderosa pine (Good Condition) (Scribing Visible) (1881 BT) bears S36°W, 16.4 feet.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 24" in the ground, replacing the rock which is turned upside down and buried on the north side of the monument. Built a mound of rock & earth to be 28" in diameter by 6" high around the monument, from which a new BT is:

9" Ponderosa pine bears N59° 30'E, 15.5 feet scribed 1/4 S30 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were taken with a staff compass, using a declination of 18° 30'E, to stamped brass washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground. Set steel fence posts 5 feet N and 5 feet W of the corner on the National Forest property lines. Attached Forest Boundary signs to each post and an Attention sign to the N post.
