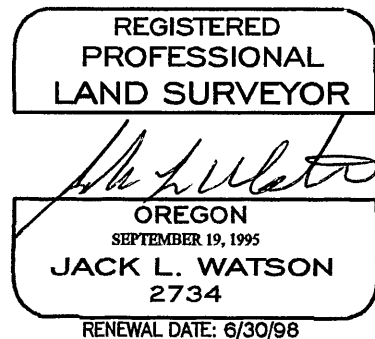

Description of monument and accessories set at corner location:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached 1 1/2" aluminum cap, the cap is stamped as shown in the diagram.

From which I scribe new bearing trees:

A 14" P.Pine bears S56°E, 28.24 feet, marked CS1/16S28BT.

A 11" P.Pine bears S37°W, 78.82 feet, marked CS1/16S28BT.

I used magnetic compass, with 20° east variation, to center of BT's and steel tape measuring to a 50d nail driven in the side center at the root crown of the BT's. Built a mound of stone around monument.
