

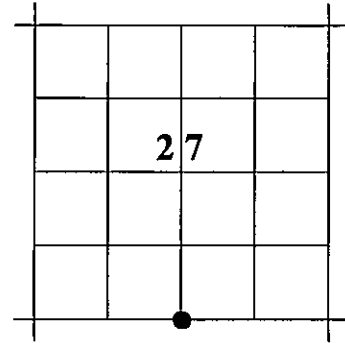

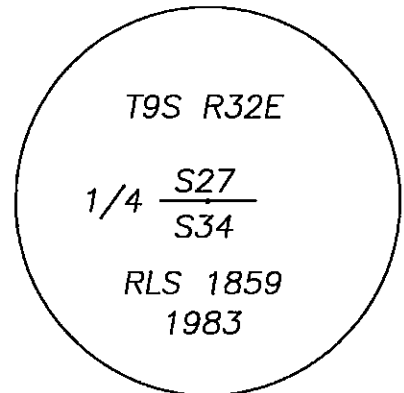
ORIGINAL GLO DESCRIPTION: *Set a basalt stone 14x12x6 ins. 9 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on N. face; from which a pine 5 ins. diam. bears North 100 lks dist. marked 1/4S. B.T. no other tree within limits and raise a mound of stone alongside.*

- ▶ **Weaver's 1983 description (also see Survey No. 766):** *Found no evidence of original stone or bearing tree. Set a 3" aluminum cap on a 30" aluminum pipe 2" above mound of stone 16" high x 60"x42" . . . from which A 17" diam. pine bears N 87°E, 22.9 feet mk'd 1/4 S27; A 16" diam. pine bears S 36° E, 37.1 feet. mk'd 1/4 S34 .*

EVIDENCE FOUND AND NEW ACCESSORIES: Found Weaver's 1983 aluminum monument in good condition in a large mound of stone. The cap is marked as shown below. I placed a fiberglass location post alongside the mound of stone. The Northeast BT taken by Weaver has been blown over and is lying on the ground. The Southeast BT has a partially healed blaze with visible scribing, but has been snapped off about 15 feet above the ground.

FROM THE FOUND MONUMENT, I SET THE FOLLOWING NEW REFERENCE POINTS:

- ▶ A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.62°47'E., 43.25 feet with attached green plastic cap marked "GCS RP"
- ▶ A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.55°15'E., 41.90 feet with attached green plastic cap marked "GCS RP "
- ▶ A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.42°09'W., 28.56 feet with attached green plastic cap marked "GCS RP "
- ▶ A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.62°35'W., 22.31 feet with attached green plastic cap marked "GCS RP "



Used RTK GPS to measure the reference points. Bearings are based on Grant County Map of Survey No. 1978
