

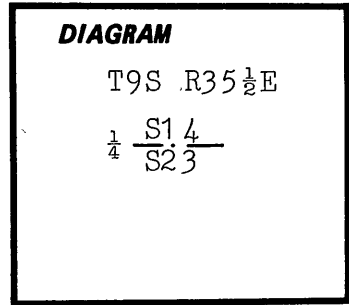
**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

N-19

**History of original corner establishment:**

This corner was originally established by W.B. Barr, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under his Contract No.492, dated August 28, 1883, during April, 1884. The original notes state that at the corner a 4' long by 3" square marked post was set 24" in the ground for the corner from which:

A 8" tamarack bears S40°E-64 lks, marked 1/4S BT.  
A 10" pine bears N40°W-200 lks, marked 1/4S BT.



**Description of corner evidence found:**

The area has been badly disturbed by logging activity this summer - the corner monument was not found. The corner position was reestablished by record bearing and distance measurement from the found western larch bearing tree. From the reestablished corner:

A 21" western larch bears S40°E-42.2' with scribing visible on previously opened top blaze and healed lower blaze.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

Set a 2½" by 30" aluminum pipe with 2½" aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:

A 11" western larch bears N63½°E-67.6' scribed 1/4 S14 BT.

New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post East of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Cap is marked:

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on October 4, 1985.
